We thank you and appreciate all the effort and sacrifices you and all our public servants make on a daily basis and we will keep you in our thoughts and prayers. We know you face many difficult decisions, and we send our thoughts and prayers that you have an open mind and good advice as you move forward. Today, I write to you on behalf of the East Islip Board of Education. The East Islip Board of Education has been requesting a mask optional policy for the past six months. Due to the serious changing conditions as they relate to COVID and the Delta Variants, we want you to know we will support your decision for a mask mandate. This is clear evidence that in the name of democracy we are willing to adjust our position based on the changing needs in society. We, as the Board of Education, do have a request, our communities are bitterly divided across the state over the mask issue. We believe that giving us target numbers using the state positivity rate would give us all incentive to pull together. We would respectfully defer to your medical experts on the percentages but : when the positivity rate drops below 2%, school districts can opt to go to a restaurant style option when

masks are worn on buses, in hallways and common areas but removed when students are at their desks. If the numbers drop below 1%, districts can opt to go masks optional.
