

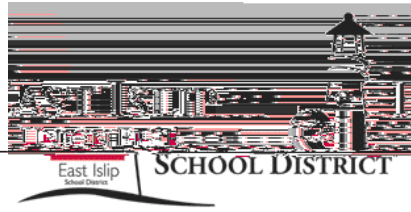

Calculation of Final Average

Full-year courses will be recorded in one of the following ways:

1. If the quarter 4 numeric grade is maintained, the final grade will be an average of all 4 four quarters. (As listed in example Student A)
2. If the quarter 4 numeric grade is replaced with a Pass (P), the final grade will be an average of the first three quarters. (As listed in example Student B)
3. If the quarter 4 numeric grade is 64 and below, that grade will remain, and the final grade will be an average of all four quarters. Staff will review the circumstances of all students who meet the criteria before determining whether to over-ride a failing grade. (As listed in example C)

Semester Courses will be recorded in one of the following ways:

1. If the quarter 4 numeric grade is maintained, the final grade will be an average of quarters 3 and 4.
2. If the quarter 4 numeric grade is replaced with a Pass (P), the final grade will be the grade for quarter 3.
3. If the quarter 4 numeric grade is 64 and below, that grade will remain, and the final grade will be an average of quarter 3 and quarter 4. Staff will review the circumstances of all students who meet the criteria before determining whether to over-ride a failing grade.

If clarification is needed on the grading for the 4th marking period or final grade, please contact your child's school counselor.
