The Infinite Campus Parent Portal is a special tool that enables parents to monitor the educational growth. Use of the portal helps to strengthen communication between home and school. Parents and legal guardians will be able to view different areas of information concerning their child(ren). Each parent or legal guardian of a student in our District will be assigned a unique user login. By activating their user account, parents and legal guardians agree to abide by and support the terms of use and user expectations set forth in this document.

Section 1: User Expectations

A) Access Information

Access to the portal is a free service offered to all parents or legal

limited to violation of federal and state data privacy laws. Anyone found to be in violation of these laws will be subject to civil and/or criminal prosecution.

Parents/legal guardians who identify a security problem within the portal must notify their school immediately by sending an email to parentportal@eischools.org, and without demonstrating the problem to anyone else.

Parents/legal guardians will not share their passwords or allow anyone other than themselves to use their Parent Portal accounts, including their own child(ren).

Parents/legal guardians will not set any computer to automatically log in to the Parent Portal.

Parents/legal guardians will log out of their Parent Portal user accounts when they are not at their computer.

Parents/legal guardians identified as a security risk will be denied access to the sites.

E) Security Features

Access is made available through a secure Internet site. Account holders are responsible for protecting their passwords and for properly protecting or destroying any printed or electronic documentation generated from or about the Parent Portal site. Unsuccessful login attempts may disable the user's account. In order to use the account again the user will need to contact the Parent Portal Help Desk at parentportal@eischools.org Users may be automatically logged off if they leave their web browser open and inactive for a period of time.

Parent or guardian accounts will be deactivated when all their children have either withdrawn or graduated from East Islip Public School District, or a court action denies the parent or guardian access to his/her child's information.
